The LOPC Foundation is a tax-exempt corporation formed in 1992 to support and expand the long-range mission of Lafayette-Orinda Presbyterian Church beyond the capability of the annual operating budget. The Foundation provides information and assistance to potential donors, receives gifts in various forms and designations, manages investments, responds to extraordinary needs and opportunities in carrying out the church's ministries, and acts as trustee to honor the terms of ongoing trust created by donors.

Grant Application Process

As of September 30, every year, the LOPC Foundation determines the amount of funds available to support the ministries of LOPC. During October, November and December the Foundation advises the Session and Deacons of the funds that are available for Foundation grants in the coming year. These organizations and any LOPC member may initiate grant requests at any time using a simple Grant Application Form. The Trustees will act on the requests after they have been approved by a sponsoring LOPC organization, then prioritized and approved by Session or Deacons.
